



2019 Wales Motorcycle Federation Solo Enduro Championship

ET James sponsored 2019 Welsh Enduro Championship.

A competitor must be of proven Welsh birth, either or both parents of proven Welsh birth or have been a continuous resident in Wales for a period of not less than three years prior to the 1st January 2019.

Championship to comprise of:

1. Snowrun Enduro (WTRA) 3rd February 2019
2. Jack Frost Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 31st March 2019
3. Caio Enduro (DDBC) 19th May 2019
4. Welsh Two Day Enduro 27th & 28th June 2019
5. Hafren BEC Two Day (Hafren) 3rd and 4th August 2019
6. Trevor Evans Memorial Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 24th August 2019
7. Hundred House Enduro (Builth Wells) 14th September 2019
8. Jacko Enduro (CWAC) 29th September 2019

Classes are: Championship, Expert, Clubman, O40's and O50's.

This year the WMF Enduro Committee has agreed to allow riders in the Expert class the opportunity to experience riding in the Championship class. Riders are able to ride in the Championship class for all events other than the Hafren BEC where riders will be allowed to revert back to the Expert class to support their BEC campaign. They will be allowed to claim points at the Hafren even riding Expert to support their Welsh Championship campaign in the Championship class.

This gives 10 days of competition with 8 days to count.

In the occurrence of events being cancelled we reserve the right to revoke the option for riders to drop their lowest scores.

In the event of a tie the best performance in the last round of the series will decide the winner.

This year the WMF Enduro Committee has agreed to run a championship dedicated to Under 19's.

This is to be run on clubmen or expert schedule and comprises of the following events: -

1. Jack Frost Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 31st March 2019
2. Drovers Enduro (WTRA) 21st April 2019
3. Caio Enduro (DDBC) 19th May 2019
4. Brechfa Enduro (DDBC) TBD
5. Trevor Evans Memorial Enduro (Rhayader MCC & LCC) 24th August 2019
6. Jacko Enduro (CWAC) 29th September 2019

This gives 6 days of competition with 6 days to count.

Please note that although this is an under 19's class ACU rules apply to the competitors, refer to the ACU handbook.

It is the **rider's responsibility** to gain entry to the events as organisers cannot guarantee an entry even though the event is in the Welsh Championship. **Please be mindful to get your entries in as early as possible!!**
